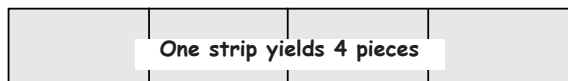
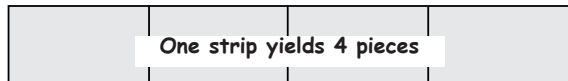


3: Cut (3) 5-3/4" by 42" strips. Sub-cut (12) 5-3/4" by 10-1/2" pieces. Place these pieces into Bag #1 with *Unit-H, Template Layout Sheets*.



4: Cut (4) 5-3/4" by 42" strips. Sub-cut (16) 5-3/4" by 10" pieces. Place these pieces into Bag #6 with *Unit-HS, Template Layout Sheets*.



5: Cut (1) 4-1/2" by 42" strip. Sub-cut (8) 4-1/2" squares. Place these pieces into Bag #6 with *Template HS-3*.

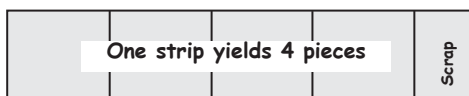


6: Cut (2) 11" by 42" strips. Place both strips into Bag #4 with *Template 1*.

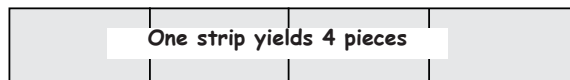
7: Cut (1) 24" by 42" strip. Place this strip into Bag #5 with *Template 3*.

**Color Family #4, Green (Print) Light Fabric #11:**

1: Cut (7) 7-1/2" by 42" strips. Sub-cut (28) 7-1/2" by 8-1/2" pieces. Clip these pieces together and place them into Bag #2 with *Template CG-2, Layout Sheets*.

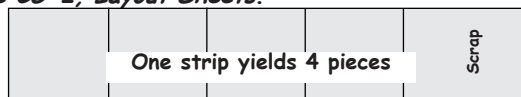


2: Cut (7) 5-3/4" by 42" strips. Sub-cut (28) 5-3/4" by 10-1/2" pieces. Place these pieces into Bag #1 with *Unit-H, Template Layout Sheets*.

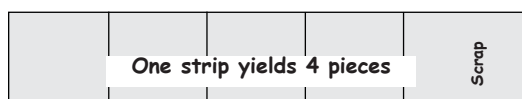


**Color Family #4, Green (Mottled) Light Fabric #12:**

1: Cut (4) 7-1/2" by 42" strips" Sub-cut (16) 7-1/2" by 8-1/2" pieces. Clip these pieces together and place them into Bag #2 with *Template CG-2, Layout Sheets*.



\* 2: Cut (2) 7-1/2" by 42"strips" Sub-cut (8) 7-1/2" by 9-1/2" pieces. Clip these pieces together and place them into Bag #7 with \* *Template CG-3 Mirror, Layout Sheets*.



3: Cut (1) 98" by 42" strip. Sub-cut (5) 8" by 98" strips along the selvage grain. Place these pieces back into Bag #5.

\* Reference can be made to the graphic in the next column.

**Cutting Templates: 1, 3, 4, & 5:** The sub-cutting is completed for all the template pieces in the instructions below.

*Note: Accuracy is important when cutting the pieces for the templates so don't stack more than you can cut through at one time. The Templates are used multiple times to complete the cutting .*

**Bag #5: Template 4, Cutting Instructions:**

1. **In Bag #5 you will find (4) 8" by 98"strips**, cut from Fabric #12. Layer and stack the strips *wrong-sides-together*. Use Template 4, and cut (16) pieces.

2. Clip (4) pieces cut with Template 4, together and mark the pieces with a sticky-note that says (*Template 4, Block 11, Corner Pieces*). Place these pieces back into Bag #5.

4. Stack the remaining (12) Template 4 pieces with *wrong-sides-together* into one pile. Clip 'Template 4' back onto your pieces. Place a ruler on the dashed line where it says **CUT LINE FOR 12 PIECES**. Using your rotary cutter, cut the corner off each piece. Re-stack the pieces *right-side-up* into (2) groups. Refer to the graphic below and mark each group with a sticky-note: (*Template 4, Block 9*) (*Template 4 Block 10*). Place these back into Bag #5.

**Bag #5: Template 5, Cutting Instructions:**

1: **In Bag #5 you will find (3) 6-1/2" by 42" strips** previously cut from Fabric #2. Use Template 5 and cut (16) pieces. Place the pieces back into Bag #5.



2: **In Bag # 5 you will find one 8" by 98" strips** previously cut from Fabric #12. Use Template 5 and cut (8) pieces. Refer to the graphic below. Place the pieces back into Bag #5.
