

Finishing the Quilt, Step 1: Template E is sewn onto Unit HB1-R. The fabrics are placed *right-sides-together*. Match, and pin, the intersections together where the stitching lines intersect on each unit. A few additional pins placed along the raw edge will keep the fabric from shifting while sewing the seam together.


Step 3: Unit DR is sewn onto the grouping with right-sides-together. Three pins are used to match the A, B, & C, registration points. Additional pins should be used to match the quarter inch intersections on the sewing lines. Make (4) sets.

8 on Unit-DL. Then press the seams facing towards Template E.




Step 4: Remove the foundation paper under sections 2, 4, 6, & 8, on Unit-DR. Press seams facing towards Unit DR.

Step 1: Template E is sewn onto Unit HB1-L. The fabrics are matched and pinned with *right-sides-together* at each intersection on the stitching line. Use your pins or your glue to secure the raw edges before you sew.



Step 1: Template D is sewn onto Unit HB2-L. The fabrics are matched and pinned with *right-sides-together* at each intersection on the stitching line. Use your pins or your glue to secure the raw edges.



Step 1: Template D is sewn onto Unit HB2-R. The fabrics are matched and pinned with *right-sides-together* at each intersection on the stitching line. Use your pins or your glue to secure the raw edges.
