# Feathered Star wall Hanging Chapter 1: 

## Bag \#1, Unit-AR: Bag \#2, Unit-AL: Bag \#3, Unit-AS:

Round 1: Cutting Instructions, Colors C1, C2, C3, C4,

Cutting the Strips: You should have four fabrics, (Colors C1, C2, C3, and C4), which were placed with this chapter when you built the fabric charts. These fabrics are used to complete the cutting and piecing for the three A-Units in Round 1.

Sub Cut the following strips from each color. The strips are used to complete the cutting with the Template Layout Sheets.

Color C1, Accent Center Star: Cut (1) 3-3/4" by 42" strip across the width of the fabric. Place with Bag 1.
Color C2, Accent Center Star: Cut (1) 3-3/4" by 42" strip across the width of the fabric. Place with Bag 1.
Color C3, Accent Spike: Cut (6) 4" by 42" strip across the width of your fabric. Place (3) strips with Bag \#1, (3) strips with Bag \#2 and the remaining fabric in Bag \#3.
Color C4, Background: Cut (8) 4-1/4" by 42" strip across the width of your fabric. Place (4) strips with Bag \#1 and (4) strips with Bag \#2

The graphics were provided as a reference to help you with the sub-cutting of each strip.

Note: When you cut the fabric pieces for the templates or template layout sheets, the pieces you cut should measure either the same size or just a little larger than the templates and template layout sheets.

## Background Fabric, Color C4 Sub-cutting Instructions

## Unit-AR: Background Template Layout Sheet, Bag \#1,

1. Open and stack (4) of the $4-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ by $42^{\prime \prime}$ strips cut from Background Color C4, right-side-up into (1) stack.

2. Position the Unit-AR Background, Template Layout Sheet as shown below onto the (4) strips.

3. Sub-cut (4) fabric pieces to match the size and shape of the template layout sheet.

4. Rotate the template layout sheet 180 degrees and reposition it onto the strips. Cut (4) more pieces.

5. Place the end pieces into Bag \#3 with the Unit-AS Background Template Layout Sheet.

Unit-AR, BKG Layout Sheet

6. Center the (8) pieces you cut under the template layout sheet as shown.
7. Slice through the paper and fabric on Lines 1-4. Use your paper clips, clip
 the templates and fabric pieces together for each section and place the pieces back into Bag \#1 with the foundation papers for Unit-AR.

## Unit-AL: Background Template Layout Sheet: Bag \#2,

1. Open and stack the (4) remaining $4-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ by $42^{\prime \prime}$ strips cut from Background Color C4, right-side-up into (1) stack.

2. Use the Unit-AL Background, Template Layout Sheet and cut (8) fabric pieces to match the size and shape of the template layout sheet. Repeat the previous steps, cut the first (4) pieces, then rotate and reposition the layout sheet to cut the last (4) pieces.

3. The end pieces are placed in Bag \#3 with the Unit-AS Background Template Layout Sheet.
4. Center the (8) pieces under the template layout sheet as shown.

5. Slice through the paper and fabric on Lines 1-4. Clip the templates onto the fabric pieces and place the pieces back into Bag \#2 with the foundation papers for Unit-AL.
