Step 5: Bag \#1: Sub-cut (1) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strip into (2) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 20-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Place into Bag \#1-4 for now. They will be cut later.

Step 6: Bags \#4 and \#5: Stack (2) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips and sub-cut (6) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Place (3) into Bag \#4-1 and (3) into Bag \#5-1. These will be cut later.

Step 7: Bag \#2: Place the $10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strip right-side-up on the cutting board and remove the Unit B Background Template Layout Sheet from Bag \#3-4. Using the Template Layout Sheet as a guide, cut (8) pieces of fabric to the size of the Template Layout Sheet.


Step 8: Restack the pieces of fabric into one stack, then place the Unit B Background Template Layout Sheet on top and cut on the Cut Lines, in order, until you have cut the entire Template Layout Sheet apart.

Step 9: Paperclip the template to the stack of fabric beneath and place the clipped stacks back into Bag \#3-4.

Step 10: Bag \#3: Place the $12^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strip right-side-up on the cutting board and remove the Unit A Background Template Layout Sheet from Bag \#2-4. Using the Template Layout Sheet as a guide, cut (8) pieces of fabric to the size of the Template Layout Sheet.


Step 11: Restack the pieces of fabric into one stack, then place the Unit A Background Template Layout Sheet on top and cut on the Cut Lines, in order, until you have cut the entire Template Layout Sheet apart.


Step 12: Paperclip the template to the stack of fabric beneath and place the clipped stacks back into Bag \#2-4.

- (2) $8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ Strips.

Step 2: Bag \#6: Subcut the (3) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips into the following background pieces and place into Bag \#6-3.

- (1) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 16-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Strip and (1) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Strip.
- (1) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 32-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Strip.
- (1) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 28-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Strip.

Step 3: Bag \#3 and \#1: Subcut the (1) $8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strip into the following background pieces and place into the corresponding bag.

- (1) $8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 32-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Strip (Bag \#6-3).
- (1) $8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Strip (Bag \#6-3).
- Remove a Template D-2 from Bag \#1-3. Place it on the remnants of the above strip and cut (3) triangles. Clip to the template and place back into Bag \#1-3.

Step 4: Sub-cut the $5^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strip into (4) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Place (2) into Bag \#4-1 and (2) into Bag \#5-1. They will be cut later.

- (1) $10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ Strip.
- (1) $12^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ Strip.

Step 2: Bag \#6: Subcut the (1) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips into the following and place into Bag \#6-2:

- (1) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 24-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip.
- (1) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 16-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip.

Step 3: Bag \#2 and \#6: Subcut the (1) $9^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strip into the following and place in the respective bag:

- (1) $9^{\prime \prime} \times 9^{\prime \prime}$ square (move to the next step).
- (2) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 24-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips (Bag \#6-2).

Step 7: Bag \#2: Place the $10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strip right-side-up on the cutting board and remove the Unit B Background Template Layout Sheet from Bag \#3-2. Using the Template Layout Sheet as a guide, cut (8) pieces of fabric to the size of the Template Layout

Sheet. Restack the pieces of fabric right-sides-up and use the Unit B Background Template Layout Sheet to cut apart the templates.
