Corner Sets

The corner sections are sewn together and pressed before sewing them onto the center quilt top. Pay attention to the location of the Section 5 Template pieces around the border. Refer to the **Queen Size Block Layout on page 11**

Corner 1: Build (2) Corner Sets:

Top Right, and Bottom Left Corners. The corner blocks are sewn in ascending order. Illustration 1



Sewing on the Corners Sections

1. Both corner sections are sewn onto the center quilt top. Press the seams towards the center Glacier Star Quilt.



2. Both corner sections are sewn onto the center quilt top to complete the quilt. Press the seams towards the Center Glacier Star Quilt.



*Selecting Background Fabrics for the Glacier Star Queen Border.

Background Fabric #4 is used for (8) Section 4 Template pieces and background fabrics for the H-Unit. This fabric should be very similar in color and value, as Background Fabric #2 used for in the Glacier Star. *Note: The Glacier Star, Fabric #2 could be used in place of Fabric #4*.

Background Fabrics #5 is used behind the Geese. This fabric should be very similar in color and value, as Background Fabric #3 in the Glacier Star. Note: Again the Glacier Star, Fabric #3 could be used in place of Fabric #5.

*Selecting Accent Fabrics for the Glacier Star Queen Border.

Fabric #12 and Fabric #10 should be complimentary colors. This will provide a third frame around the quilt.

Accent Fabric #11 is similar in value but different in color, than the fabric used for Accent Fabric #9 in the Glacier Star.

Accent Fabric #12 should be a different color than Accent Fabric #10 in the Glacier Star.

Geese Fabrics: The left over fabrics from the geese in the original quilt can be added to new fabrics for the outer border geese.
