<u>Color C13, Border Templates, Bag #10,</u> <u>Template HB2-L, Template HB2-R</u> <u>Template HB4-L, Template HB4-R</u>

1. Open and stack the (4) 5-1/2" by 42" strips cut from Color, C13, *right-side-up*.



2. Use the templates below to cut the following pieces. Each cut provides (4) pieces. Refer to the template arrangement in *Illustration 3* below when completing the cutting for the HB template pieces. Note the HB2-L & HB2-R templates are used more than once to cut the additional pieces.

Templates, HB2-L & HB2-R: Cut (4) pieces from each strip for a total of (16) left and (16) right pieces.

Templates, **HB4-L & HB4-R**: Cut (1) piece from each strip for a total of (4) left and (4) right pieces.



3. After the pieces are cut, clip the fabric template pieces together and place them into Bag #10. Note that templates HB2-L and HB2-R are used again to cut additional pieces from fabric Color C14 so don't put them away!

<u>Color C14, Border Templates, Bag #10,</u> <u>Template-HB2-L, Template-HB2-R</u> <u>Template-HB5-L, Template-HB5-R</u>

1. Open and stack the (4) 5-1/2" by 42" strips cut from Color, C14, *right-side-up*.



2. Use the templates below to cut the following pieces. Each cut provides (4) pieces. Refer to the template arrangement in *Illustration 4* below when completing the cutting for the HB template pieces. Note the HB2-L & HB2-R templates are used more than once to cut the additional pieces.

Templates, HB2-L & HB2-R: Cut (4) pieces from each strip for a total of (16) each left and right pieces.

Templates, HB5-L & HB5-R: Cut (1) piece from each strip for a total of (4) left and (4) right pieces.



3. After the pieces are cut clip the fabric template pieces together and place them into Bag #10.

Border Fabric Color Layout Exploded Layout

You need to find the Exploded Layout for the Feathered Star before you can continue. The Exploded Layout should have been placed with Chapter 5 when you cut out the foundation papers and templates in the Introduction Booklet.

At the bottom of the Exploded Layout you will find the Color #'s printed on each section of the border layout. On the foundation papers you will find the template numbers printed on each section.

Note, that the exploded layout is a drawing of the front-side view of the finished quilt which is a mirror image of the lines printed on the foundation papers.

Position the foundation papers in the order they will be sewn together at your table. Position the papers with the backside facing up. This means you will not see the printed lines. You should have **(4)** foundation papers in each stack.

Trace the dashed lines on the *backside* of the first unit in each stack to show the individual sections on the *backside* of the paper.



Before you begin paper piecing match the templates up with each section of the foundation papers. Arrange the fabric pieces following the order of the color layout on each set of foundation units. Stack four fabric pieces for each section. Note make sure the fabric pieces are positioned facing *right-side-up*.



Foundation Paper Piecing Unit HB1-R, Bag #10



Step 1: Place Unit-HB1-R *right-side-up* on your table and position as shown.

Step 2: Find Sec. 1 on the foundation paper. Place a small amount of fabric glue on the *back-side* of the paper / under Sec. 1.





Step 3: Position the first piece of fabric for Sec. 1 *wrong-side-up* on your table. Lift the foundation paper, slide & glue the fabric under Sec. 1.

Step 4: Place the fold template over the top of Sec. 1. Fold the paper back and trim the fabric with your rotary cutter.



Step 5: Place the fabric piece for Sec. 2, *right-side-up* next to the folded back paper.

Step 6: Lift the foundation paper and slide the fabric under Sec. 2. Line the sew-side up with the trimmed quarter-inch seam allowance. Open the paper, and sew on Line 1.





Step 7: Loosen the glue under Sec. 1, flip the paper over and press the fabric.

Step 8: Continue adding the pieces for sections 3, 4, 5, & 6.





Step 10: Place the fold template on Line 6 and carefully fold back the paper releasing the stitching on lines 1-5.

Step 11: Place the Add-A-Quarter ruler next to the folded back section, lip-side down and trim a quarter-inch seam allowance.

Remove the 2" strips, cut from fabric Color C4, and the 1-1/2" strips, cut from fabric Color C1, in Bag #10.

Two strips are used from each color to cut **(8)** pieces measuring 11" long. This measurement is just a bit longer than the foundation papers for the unit you are working on.



Step 12: Position the first 2" strips, cut from fabric Color C4, under the foundation paper, lining the raw edges up with the trimmed quarter inch seam allowance. Open the paper and sew on Line 6.

Step 13: Fold, trim, and sew the second strip for Line 7 onto the foundation paper. Note the second strip was cut from fabric Color C1 and measures 1-1/2" wide.

After the foundation piecing is finished for the left side units return to Step 1 and repeat the same process for completing the right side units.





Note the HB1-R units are a mirror image so the graphic will appear to be backwards.

Trim the excess fabric off each unit to complete your pieces. Do not remove the foundation papers at this time.

Finishing the Border Units Bag #10, HB2-L, HB2-R, HB3-L,HB3-R

The pieces for the remaining units are stacked and pieced by following the same previous steps. The strip sizes for each unit are listed below.

HB2 Unit, Inner Border Strip, Color C4: Cut (8) pieces, 2" by 14". HB2 Unit, Inner Border Strip, Color C1: Cut (8) pieces, 1-1/2" by 14".

HB3 Unit, Inner Border Strip, Color C4: Cut (8) pieces, 2" by 4-1/2". HB3 Unit, Inner Border Strip, Color C1: Cut (8) pieces, 1-1/2" by 4-1/2".
