1-B, place these into Bag #1. Repeat the process, for Groups 2-A, 2-B (Bag #2), 3-A, 3-B (Bag #3), and 4-A, 4-B (Bag #4). When you are finished, discard Bag #5. As above, the shuffling process will be completed with 8 fabrics instead of 7.

<u>Osprey's Nest, Bag #6, #7, #8, and #9:</u>

Remove all the fabric pieces, foundation papers, and template layout sheets from Bag #6. The layout sheets and fabric pieces are sorted, and clipped together with the foundation units. After the content in each bag has been sorted, the groupings are place back into a smaller bag of their own, then placed back into their original bag. The cutting apart of the template layouts sheets will take place later in the instructions. For now, do not cut the template layout sheets.

Bag #6, Group 1 of 4:

Step 1: Clip one Unit A, Template A1 Layout Sheet onto (8) 3" by 12" Light Fabrics cut from Nest Fabric #13.

Bags #7 to #9: The organization process in the previous Steps 1-16 for the templates, fabrics, and foundation papers are repeated for the pieces in Bag #7 through #9. The previous steps can be used as a reference as you sort your pieces. After the pieces are sorted, return each group, placed into a sub-bag and labeled, back into its original bag.

When you have reached the end of the cutting instructions, you should have the following bags in preparation for the foundation paper piecing process of the pattern:

Bag #1, Group 1: Dark and Light Log Cabin Combinations. Bag #2, Group 2: Dark and Light Log Cabin Combinations. Bag #3, Group 3: Dark and Light Log Cabin Combinations. Bag #4, Group 4: Dark and Light Log Cabin Combinations. Bag #6, Groups 1-4: Osprey's Nest Combinations. Bag #7, Groups 1-4: Osprey's Nest Combinations. Bag #8, Groups 1-4: Osprey's Nest Combinations. Bag #9, Groups 1-4: Osprey's Nest Combinations.
