Step 2: Sort the strips as follows: Put (3) of Fabric #C5 into each of Bags #2 and #4. Put (3) of Fabric #C6 into each of Bags #3 and #5.

Cutting for Bags #2 and #3, Unit A Cut (72) 3" x 12" strips, (36) Per Bag:

Step 3: Starting with Bag #2, open and restack the (3) 12" x 42" strips in the bag facing right-side-up. Cut (14) 3" by 12" stacks of (3) strips, each. Restack the pieces into (6) stacks of (6) strips, right-side-up. Discard the remaining strips.



Step 4: Place (1) Unit A, Template A1 Layout Sheet from Bag #2 onto (3) of the stacks and (1) Unit A, Template A2 Layout Sheet from Bag #2 onto each of the (3) remaining stacks.

Step 5: Use paperclips to clip each section of the Unit A, Template A1 Layout Sheet onto the stack of rectangles beneath.



NOTE - Paper Clip Placement: Be careful not to place the clips so they overlap lines.

Step 6: Cut the Unit A Template A1 Layout Sheet

and fabrics apart, starting on Line 1 and continuing through Line 5. Place back in Bag #2.

Step 7: Repeat Steps 5 and 6 with the Unit A Template A2 Layout Sheet stacks.



Step 8: Move onto Bag #3. Complete Steps 3 to 7 above, except your background fabric is the dark arc background Fabric #C6 (use Unit A, Template A1 Layout Sheet and Unit A, Template A2 *Layout Sheet,* again. Three of each should already be in Bag #3). When the cutting is complete, place the pieces back into Bag #3.

Cutting for Bags #4 and #5, Unit B Cut (84) 3" x 12" strips, (42) Per Bag:

Step 9: Move onto Bag #4. Open and restack the (3) 12" x 42" strips in the bag facing right-side-up. Cut (14) 3" x 12" stacks of (3) strips, each. Restack the pieces into (6) stacks of (7) strips, right-side-up. This time, there are no remaining strips to discard.

Step 10: Repeat Steps 4 through 7 using the light background fabric, Fabric #C5 and the Unit B, Template B1 Layout Sheets and Unit B, Template B2 Layout Sheets. When the cutting is complete, place the pieces back into Bag #4.

Step 11: Move onto Bag #5. This bag is completed identically to Steps #9 and #10, using the dark background fabric, Fabric #C6 and Unit B, Template B1 Layout Sheet and Unit B, Template B2 Layout Sheet. When the cutting is complete, place the pieces back into Bag #5.

UNIT A AND UNIT B OSPREY CUTTING **INSTRUCTIONS: BAGS #2 TO #5**

Step 1: Cut (20) 2-1/2" by 42" strips from Fabric #C7, and (20) 2-1/2" by 42" strips from Fabric #C8. Keep the colors separated.

Step 2: Open and restack each Fabric into (4) stacks of (5), for a total of (8) stacks, with the strips facing right-side-up.

Step 3: Cut each stack into (2) 2-1/2" by 18" pieces.





Step 4: Discard (1) 2-1/2" x 18" piece from each color and sort as follows:

- (3) Stacks of (6) 2-1/2" x 18" strips of Fabric #C7 (Bag #2). •
- (3) Stacks of (7) 2-1/2" x 18" strips from Fabric #C7 (Bag #4).
- (3) Stacks of (6) 2-1/2" x 18" strips of Fabric #C8 (Bag #3).
- (3) Stacks of (7) 2-1/2" x 18" strips from Fabric #C8 (Bag #5).

Step 5: Remove (3) Template G Layout Sheets from Bag #2. Place (1) each, onto the (3) stacks cut from Fabric #C7.





Step 6: Cut the Template apart, starting on Cut Line 1 and continuing through Cut Line 5. Place in Bag #2.

Step 7: Remove (3) Template G Layout Sheets from Bag #3. Place (1) each, onto the (3) stacks cut from Fabric #C8.

Step 8: Cut apart starting on Cut Line 1 and continuing through Cut Line 5. Place in Bag #3.

Step 9: Remove (3) Template G Layout Sheets from Bag #4. Place (1), each, onto the (3) stacks cut from Fabric #C7 and cut apart starting on Cut Line 1 and continuing through Cut Line 5. Place back into Bag #4.

Step 10: Remove (3) Template G Layout Sheets from Bag #5. Place (1), each, onto the (3) stacks cut from Fabric #C8 and cut apart starting on Cut Line 1 and continuing through Cut Line 5. Place back into Bag #5.
