Step 6: Clip the template and fabric pieces together for each section. At this time place these pieces back into Bag #2 with the foundation papers for Unit E.



Step 7: From color NYB #12, cut (2) 9-1/2" by 42" strips. Open and re-stack the strips right-side-up.



Step 8: Sub-cut (4) 7-3/4" by 9-1/2" rectangles from each strip for a total of (8) pieces.



Step 9: Stack (8) pieces together facing right-side-up.

Step 10: Position the Unit E Spike Template Layout Sheet onto the stack.

Step 11: Slice through the paper and fabric on Lines 1-5, in numerical order, with the rotary cutter to separate each template piece.



Step 12: Clip the templates and fabric pieces together and place these pieces back into Bag #2 with the foundation papers for Unit E.



Small Star Unit S: Bag #3

Step 1: From color NYB #11, cut (2) 5" by 42" strips. Open and re-stack the strips facing right-side-up.



Step 2: Sub-cut (4) 5" by 7-1/2" rectangles from each strip for a total of (8) pieces.



Step 3: Stack the (8) pieces together into one pile.

Step 4: Position the Unit S Background, Template Layout Sheet, found in Bag #3, onto your stack.



Step 5: Slice through the paper and fabric on Lines 1-4, in numerical order, with your rotary cutter to separate the template pieces for each section.



Step 6: Clip the templates and fabric pieces together for each section. Place these pieces in Bag #3 with the foundation papers for Unit S.

Step 7: From color NYB #13, cut two (2) 5" by 42" strips. Open and re-stack the strips facing right-side-up.



Step 8: Sub-cut sixteen (16) 1-1/2" by 5" rectangles from each strip for a total of thirty-two (32) pieces.



Step 9: Clip the fabric pieces together. Place these pieces with the foundation papers for Unit S in Bag #3.

Border Units A-1, A-2, A-3, and A-4: Bag #4

Step 1: Find colors CB #16, CB #17, CB #18, and CB #19.

Step 2: Cut two (2) 5" by 42" strips from each color listed above.

Step 3: Open and re-stack (1) strip from each color facing wrong-side-up.



Step 4: Open and re-stack the remaining strips from each color facing right-side-up.

Step 5: Layer the stacks with wrong-sides-together. You should now have (8) strips in your stack, (4) strips are facing wrong-side-up and the other (4) strips are facing right-side-up. (Graphic at top of next page).
