Foundation Papers and Templates:

Step 1: Cut out (8) each of the Foundation Papers for Unit D on NP 399, along with (4) of each Template Layout Sheets on TP 220. See the following newsprint graphics for information on how to organize your units and templates into their corresponding bags. *Refer back to General Information for Foundation papers and templates for additional instructions on how to prepare your foundation papers and templates.

Fabric D1 (TLS) Unit D

Step 1: Cut and stack (6) 5" by 42" strip facing right-side up.

Step 2: The Unit D Accent Template D1-1 Layout Sheet is placed onto the strips as shown. Cut (16) pieces, matching the size and shape of the Template Layout Sheet. You will cut (3) pieces from (5) strips and (1) piece from one strip.



Step 3: Stack (8) pieces under each Template Layout Sheet. The cutting is completed by slicing through the paper on each cut line to separate the individual sections. Paper clips are used to keep the fabric and template pieces together. Place these pieces with the Unit D Foundation Papers in Bag #8.



Fabric D2: (TLS) Unit D

Step 1: Cut and stack (6) 5-1/4" by 42" strips facing right-side up.



Step 2: The Unit D Background Template D1-2 Layout Sheet is placed onto the strips as shown. Cut (16) pieces, matching the size and shape of the Template Layout Sheet. You will cut (3) pieces from (5) strips and (1) piece from one strip.



Step 3: Stack (8) pieces under each Template Layout Sheet. The cutting is completed by slicing through the paper on each cut line to separate the individual sections. Paper clips are used to keep the fabric and template pieces together. Place these pieces with the Unit D Foundation Papers in Bag #8.



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
