Step 11: Position the fold template over the top of Sections 1 and 2, lining the edge up with Line 2. Fold the paper back and tear the paper along the stitches on Line 1. Stop tearing when you hit the fold template.

Step 12: Use the *Add-A-Quarter* ruler to trim the excess fabric, then place the 3rd fabric next to the foundation paper. Lift the foundation unit on top, lining up the sew-side with the trimmed

Step 13: Take the pieces to your machine, sew on Line 2, open and press.



Repeat the Previous Steps: Repeat the process for each section. When the

paper piecing is complete you will need to complete the sewing on the registration lines. After sewing the *(TRP)*.... Lines, trim off the excess paper and fabric on the dark solid line around the perimeter of the printed paper. The paper is not removed at this time. Place all of the B Units back into Bag # Sunrise B1.

Step 1: From Fabric C1, cut (4) 17" x 42" Strips. Stack the strips *right-side-up* into (2) stacks. Use the *Unit C1L Background TLS* to sub-cut (4) fabric pieces the size of the Template Layout Sheet from (2) of the strips.



Step 2: Re-stack the pieces with their respective TLS on top. Then slice through the paper and fabric on each cut lines, in numerical order, to cut the pieces apart. Clip each stack together. Place the pieces for C1L into Bag #C1L.
