### Cutting Instructions Fabric S9 & S10:

Step 1: Cut (1) 4" by 42" strip, from each Fabric S9 & S10.

Step 2: Stack the strips facing right-side-up into (1) stack. Position the Unit AL & BL Template A-2 Layout Sheet onto the strips and cut (3) pieces matching the size of the TLS. Then, position the Unit AR & BR Template A-1 Layout Sheet onto the strip and cut the other (3) pieces.



Step 3: Separate the pieces by color then stack (6) pieces, (3) from each color under each layout sheet.



**Step 4:** Cut on Line 1 to separate the

template pieces. Place each of the pieces into their appropriate bag.



# Cutting Instructions Fabric S11 and S12:

NOTE - CGRDIA: The Creative Grid Diamond Wedding Ring Template B-1, provided with the Creative Grid ruler set, CANNOT be use to cut these pieces. This pattern requires the paper piecing Template Layout Sheet which is designed for paper piecing star points on the foundation papers.

Step 1: Cut (1) 5" by 42" strip, from each Fabric S11 and S12.

Step 2: Stack the strips facing right-side-up into one stack and cut (3) 4-3/4" by 5" squares from each strip.



Step 3: Separate the pieces by color, then stack the (3) pieces cut from Fabric S11, under Unit BR, Unit BL Template B1 Layout Sheet. Stack the (3) pieces cut from Fabric S12, under the Unit BL, Template B2 Layout Sheet.

Fabric S11 with the BR Units and the pieces cut from Fabric S12 with the BL Units.

# Cutting Instructions Fabric A1:

T-Template C & T-Template D: Cut (1) 5-1/2" by 42" strip from Fabric A1. Position the strip facing *right-side-up* and cut (6) pieces with each, *T-Template C* and *T-Template D*. To complete the cutting, stack the (6) fabric pieces beneath each template and trim the pieces down to the cut size.

**NOTE - CGRDIA:** The Creative Grids Templates C & D are a great tool for cutting these little pieces down to the exact cut size.



Step 1: There is a TRP point on each piece. Mark this with a pen, then sew a basting stitch, length set at 2.8, about 1/2 inch through this point, into the center of the T-Templates.

Step 2: Place T-Template D in Bag AR/BL and T-Template C in Bag AL/BR.

## Cutting Instructions Fabric A2 and A3:

T-Template E: Cut (1) 5-1/2" by 42" strip, from each Fabric A2 & A3. Position the strips facing *right-side-up* and cut (6) pieces from each fabric using T-Template E. Stack (6) fabric pieces beneath each template, then finish cutting the pieces to the actual size of T-Temp E.



NOTE - Reduce your Yardage: If you decide to use only one color, (1) 42" strip yields (12) pieces.

**NOTE - CGRDIA:** The Creative Grids Template E is a areat tool for cutting these little pieces down to the exact cut size.

Step 3: Mark, and sew each TRP Line with a basting stitch length 2.8. Place the pieces cut from Fabric A2 into Unit AR and the pieces cut from Fabric A3 with Unit AL.

#### Cutting Instructions T-Templates C1-C6, Fabric C1

Step 1: Cut (2) 16" x 42" strips from Fabric C1. Stack the strips facing *right-side-up* on the cutting table. Position the T-Templates in Bag Group C on the strips as shown in the graphics below and cut (2) pieces for each template. Large paper clips or flower pins can be used to temporarily hold the paper in the cutting process. When you are done cutting, set the pieces aside into Bag Group C to be finished in Chapter 3.



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
