



CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS: BAGS #A1 & A2

► Fabric A1: T-Template A1

Step 1: Cut (3) 2-3/4" by 42" strips facing right-side up.

Step 2: Place (3) *T-Template A1* facing printed side up, onto the *right-side* of each strip as shown (the last strip only gets 2). Each template is pinned to the fabric to secure it. Then, a basting stitch (stitch length set at 2.8) is sewn on each of the (TRP) Lines. The excess paper and hatching is then trimmed around the perimeter of each template. Do not remove the paper. Clip the pieces together and place into Bag #A2.



Fabric A2: (T-Temp A2)

Step 1: Cut (3) 2-3/4" by 42" strips facing right-side up.

Step 2: Place (3) *T-Template A2* facing printed side up, onto the *right-side* of each strip as shown (the last strip only gets 2). Each template is pinned to the fabric to secure it. Then, a basting stitch (stitch length set at 2.8) is sewn on each of the (TRP) Lines. The excess paper and hatching is then trimmed around the perimeter of each template. Do not remove the paper. Clip the pieces together and place into Bag #A2.



Fabric A3: Unit A1/A2 (TLS #1)

Step 1: Cut and stack (4) 14" by 42" strips from Fabric A3, facing *right-side up*. The *Unit A1/A2 Template Layout Sheet* #1 is placed onto the strips as shown.



Step 2: Cut **(8)** pieces, matching the size and shape of the Template Layout Sheet.



Step 3: Stack the **(8)** pieces beneath the layout sheet. The cutting is completed by slicing through the paper on each cut line to separate the individual sections. Paper clips are used to keep the fabric and template pieces together.



Step 4: Place the *A1 Templates* in Bag #A1. Place the *A2 Templates* in Bag #A2.

▶ Fabric A4: Unit A2 (TLS #2) Unit A1 (TLS #2)

Step 1: Cut (4) 3-1/2" by 42" strips. Stack the strips into (2) stacks of (2) facing *right-side up*.

Step 2: Place the *Unit A2 Template Layout Sheet #2* onto the first stack. Cut **(8)** pieces matching the size and shape of the (TLS). Stack the pieces beneath the layout sheet and complete the cutting by slicing on each cut line to separate the individual sections. Paper clips are used to keep the fabric and template pieces together. Place the *A2 Templates* in Bag #A2.



Step 3: Place the *Unit A1 Template Layout Sheet #2* onto the second stack. Cut **(8)** pieces matching the size and shape of the (TLS). Stack the pieces beneath the layout sheet and complete the cutting by slicing on each cut line to separate the individual sections. Paper clips are used to keep the fabric and template pieces together. Place the *A1 Templates* in Bag #A1.



Fabric A5: Unit A1/A2 (TLS #3)

Step 1: Cut (4) 5-1/2" by 42" strips. Stack each strip facing *right-side up*. The *Unit A1/A2 Template Layout Sheet #3* is placed onto the strips as shown. Cut (8) pieces, matching the size and shape of the Template Layout Sheet.
