Step 16: Fabric C14, TLS #35 & TLS #36: Cut (2) 5" x 42" strips.



Step 17: Fabric C15, TLS #37 & TLS #38: Cut (2) 4" x 42" strips.



Step 18: Fabric C16, TLS #39 & TLS #40: Cut (2) 4" x 42" strips.



Step 19: Fabric C17, TLS #41 & TLS #42: Cut (2) 3-3/4" x 42" strips.



Step 20: Fabric C18, TLS #43 & TLS #44: Cut (2) 3-1/4" x 42" strips.



Step 21: Fabric C19, TLS #45 & TLS #46: Cut (2) 2-1/2" x 42" strips.



STACKING: UNITS C1R AND C1L, BAG #C1R AND #C1L



C1L template pieces are now stacked in the order that they are sewn onto the foundation paper. Position the templates and fabric pieces in numerical order facing rightside-up, with the



sew-sides aligned at the top. Start with the largest Sec. # (in this case, Sec. 14), then work in reverse numerical order, ending with Sec. 1. Note that Sec. 1 does not have a sew-side.

FOUNDATION PAPER PIECING: UNIT C1L, BAG #C1L

NOTE - Tracing the Dashed Lines: Place the foundation paper onto a light table. Flip the foundation paper over and trace the dashed lines printed on the front side of the foundation paper, onto the backside of the paper.

Step 2: Glue is used to adhere the fabric to the backside of the

paper. Repeat Steps 1 and 2 for each foundation unit.



Step 3: Place the fold template over the top of

Sec. 1 Line the edge up with the solid black line marked Line 1. Fold the paper back over the top of the fold template.

Step 4: Place the Add-A-Quarter ruler next to the folded paper and trim the fabric with your rotary cutter.
