CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS, GROUP A

► Fabric AC1:a & AC1:b: Unit A1 TLS #1, Bag #AC2

Step 1: Cut (2) 8-1/2" by 42" strips each from Fabrics AC1:a & AC1:b for a total of (4) strips. Stack the strips facing **right-side-up**, and position the *Unit A1 Template Layout Sheet #1* onto the strips as shown.



Step 2: Cut (2) stacks of (4) for a total of (8) pieces matching the size of the TLS, repositioning it for the second cut as shown.



Step 3: Restack all **(8)** pieces beneath the TLS with Fabric AC1:a on top and AC1:b on the bottom. Use paper clips to clip the paper templates to the fabric. Complete the cutting on each *Cut Line* in numerical order to separate the template pieces. Place pieces with the Unit A1 foundation papers in Bag #AC2.



► Fabric AC2: Unit A1, TLS #2, Bag #AC2

Step 1: Cut (4) 5-1/4" by 42" strips from Fabric AC2. Stack the strips facing **right-side-up**, and position the *Unit A1 Template Layout Sheet #2* onto the strips as shown.



Step 2: Cut (8) pieces matching the size of the TLS, repositioning it for the second cut.



Step 3: Restack all **(8)** pieces beneath the TLS. Paper clips are used to clip the paper templates to the fabric. Complete the cutting on each *Cut Line* in numerical order to separate the template pieces. Place these pieces with the Unit A1 foundation papers in Bag #AC2.



► Fabric AC3: Unit A1, TLS #3, Bag #AC2

Step 1: With the fabric facing **right-side-up**, cut **(1)** 2-1/2" by 42" strip from Fabric AC3. Position *Unit A1 Template Layout Sheet #3* onto the strip as shown.

Unit A1 (TLS #3)

Step 2: Cut (4) pieces matching the size of the TLS, repositioning it for the remaining cuts.

Step 3: Stack the **(4)** pieces beneath the TLS. Clip the paper templates to the fabric. Cut the fabrics and templates apart on *Cut Line 1* to yield **(8)** pieces. Place the pieces with the Unit A1 foundation papers in Bag #AC2.



▶ Fabric AC4:a & AC4:b: Unit A2 TLS #4, Bag #AC3

Step 1: Cut (2) 5-1/4" by 42" strips each from Fabric AC4:a & AC4:b for a total of (4) strips. Stack the strips facing **right-side-up**, and position the *Unit A2 Template Layout Sheet #4* onto the strips as shown.



Step 2: Cut (2) stacks of (4) for a total of (8) pieces matching the size of the TLS, repositioning it for the second cut as shown.



Step 3: Restack all **(8)** pieces beneath the TLS with Fabric AC4:a on the top and AC4:b on the bottom. Use paper clips to clip the paper templates to the fabric. Complete the cutting on each *Cut Line* in numerical order to separate the template pieces. Place pieces with the Unit A2 foundation papers in Bag #AC3.



► Fabric AC5: Unit A2, TLS #5, Bag #AC3

Step 1: With the fabric facing **right-side-up**, cut **(2)** 5-1/4" by 42" strips from Fabric AC5. Stack the strips facing right-side-up, and position the Unit A2 (TLS #5) onto the strips as shown.



Step 2: Cut (8) pieces matching the size of the TLS, repositioning it for the remaining cuts.



Step 3: Restack all **(8)** pieces beneath the TLS. Paper clips are used to clip the paper templates to the fabric. Complete the cutting on each *Cut Line* in numerical order to separate the template pieces.

Place these pieces with the Unit A2 foundation papers in Bag #AC3.

▶ Fabric AC6: Unit A2, (Temp A2-1), Bag #AC3

Step 1: With the fabric facing **right-side-up**, cut **(2)** 2-1/4" by 42" strips from Fabric AC6. Position *Unit A2 Template A2-1* onto the strips as shown.

Unit A2 (Temp A2-1)

Step 2: Cut **(4)** pieces matching the size of the TLS from each strip for a total of **(8)**. Place these pieces with the Unit A2 foundation papers in Bag #AC3.



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
