GROUP A, BAG J003: PALM LEAF STAR INSTRUCTIONS

Ziploc Storage Bags: You will need (2) bags to complete the organization for these instructions. Label the bags as follows to stay organized while cutting the Foundation Units and Templates.

- Bag #J1: (8) Unit J1 Papers and Cutting Templates
- Bag #J2: (8) Unit J2 Papers and Cutting Templates

► Preparing Foundation Papers & Templates:

Step 1: Cut out (8) ea. Unit J1 & Unit J2 on [NP 755 & NP 756]. The Templates and Template Layout Sheets (TLS) are placed in a temporary bag. After the fabric has been cut the individual Sec. Temp's and (TLS) are placed into their assigned bags with their associated foundation papers. See the newsprint graphics that follow for information on how to organize your units and templates into bags. **Refer back to General Information for Foundation papers and templates for additional instructions on how to prepare your foundation papers and templates.*





Palm Leaf Star Fabric Information:

The Unit Chart that follows includes the number and size of the precut strips for each Fabric #, and a reference to which fabrics go with the Templates and (TLS) to complete Units J1 and J2. The precut fabric strips listed on the chart are located in Group Bags as noted in the pre-cutting instructions. Also, the Fabric Reference row that requires the (8) rainbow fabrics is highlighted in Grey. Put a swatch of each next to it, or just make a note. A color layout, shown below the unit chart, gives a visual reference to the location of each Fabric Color.

Note: Each Unit is made with (1) color from each Fabric J3:a-h



NOTE - Backside Graphic: The color layout matches the printed side of the paper and the backside of the quilt.

NOTE - Stacking strips: *Templates and (TLS) are repositioned on the cut strips in Group Bag J003 to achieve the number of cuts required in the cutting Instructions. Please read carefully to ensure the correct # of pieces are stacked beneath each Template before cutting.

NOTE - Glue: Repositionable glue placed on the backside of each template will keep the templates and (TLS) from moving in the cutting process. After each cut simply reposition the temp to the next location.

► Fabrics J1, Temp J1-1

Step 1: Stack the **(2)** 4-1/2" by 42" precut strips from *Fabric J1* onto your cutting table facing *right-side up*.

Step 2: *Unit J1, Template J1-1* is used to cut (8) pieces, matching the size and shape of the template, repositioning the template for each cut.



Step 3: Paper clips are used to clip the paper template to the fabrics beneath. Place these pieces with the foundation papers in Bag #J1.



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Rainbow Star Fabric Information:

The *Unit Chart* on the previous page includes the number and size of the precut strips for each Fabric #, and a reference to which fabrics go with the (TLS) to complete the Foundation Sheets L1R-L4R, Star Group 1-4 and L1L-L4L Star Group 1-4. The precut fabric strips listed on the chart are located in Group Bags as noted in the pre-cutting instructions. Put a swatch of each next to it, or just make a note. A color layout, is provided for each left and right Star Group 1-4 on Page 16.

NOTE - Templates and (TLS) are repositioned on the cut strips to achieve the number of cuts required in the cutting instructions. Please read carefully to ensure the correct # of pieces are stacked beneath each template before cutting.

NOTE - Repositionable glue placed on the backside of each template will keep the templates and (TLS) from moving in the cutting process.

Fabric L1, L3, L5, L7, (TLS) #2 & #3

Step 1: Stack the **(4)** 2-1/2" by 42" precut strips from *Rainbow Fabric L1, L3, L5, & L7.* Stack the strips facing *right-side-up* on your cutting table in decending order. *Fabric L7* on the bottom, *Fabric L1* on the top.

Left (TLS) #2 Right (TLS) #3

Step 2: *Units L1L,L2L,L3L, L4L (TLS) #2* and *Units L1R,L2R,L3R, L4R (TLS) #3* are used to cut (3) left and (2) right pieces from each Fabric.

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(TLS) #2 (TLS) #3
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Step 3: Place the left pieces in Bag #L1, right pieces in Bag #L2.



▶ Fabric L2, L4, L6, L8, (TLS) #1 & #4

Step 1: Stack the **(4)** 2-1/2" by 42" precut strips from *Rainbow Fabric L2, L4, L6, & L8.* Stack the strips facing *right-side-up* on your cutting table in decending order starting with *Fabric L8* on the bottom, finishing with *Fabric L2* on the top.



Step 2: *Units L1L,L2L,L3L, L4L (TLS) #1* and **Units L1R,L2R,L3R, L4R** (TLS) #4 are used to cut (3) right and (2) left pieces from each Fabric.

(TLS) #1

Step 3: Place the left pieces in Bag #L1, right pieces in Bag #L2.

Bag #L1 Left

▶ Fabric L9, (TLS) #9, #10, (T-TLS) #7 & #8,

NOTE - Quiltster: If you precut your fabric strips using the Quiltster APP, you will need to subcut the 13-1/2" strip into (1) 3-1/2" strip and (4) 2-1/2" strips to achieve the number of strips listed in Step 1 and Step 3.

Step 1: Place the 3-1/2" by 42" precut strip from *Fabric L9* facing *right-side-up* on your cutting table. *T-Temp L2 Layout Sheet #9* and *T-Temp L1 Layout Sheet #10* are used to cut (4) pieces with each template.



Step 2: The **(4)** pieces are stacked beneath each Layout Sheet. Cut on Line 1 to seperate the Sec. Templates. Sew the TRP lines on each template then place **(4)** each (T-TLS) L1 & L2 into each Bag #L1 and #L2.

Step 3: Re-stack the (4) 2-1/2" by 42" precut strips from *Fabric L9*. The strips are stacked facing *right-side-up*, placing (2) strips each in (2) stacks. *Units L1R, L2R, L3R, L4R, (TLS) #7* and *Units L1L, L2L, L3L, & L4L, (TLS) #8* are used to cut (4) left and (4) right pieces for each (TLS).



Step 4: The **(4)** pieces are stacked beneath each Layout Sheet. Complete the cutting by slicing through the paper and fabric on each Cut Line. The left pieces are placed in Bag #L1, right pieces are placed in Bag #L2.

▶ Fabric L10, (TLS) #5, #6

NOTE - Quiltster: If you precut your fabric strips using the Quiltster APP, you will need to subcut each 5" strip into (2) 2-1/2" strips to achieve the number of strips listed in Step 1.

Step 1: Re-stack the **(8)** 2-1/2" by 42" precut strips from *Fabric L10*. The strips are stacked facing *right-side-up*, placing **(4)** strips in each stack. *Units L1R, L2R, L3R, & L4R, (TLS) #5* and *Units L1L, L2L, L3L, & L4L, (TLS) #6* are used to cut **(4)** left and **(4)** right pieces for each (TLS).



Step 1: The cutting is completed by slicing through the paper and fabric on each Cut Line. The left pieces are placed in Bag # L1, right pieces are placed in Bag L2.



Cutting Fabric Swatches to Label your Papers: On Page 16, there are **(8)** Star Groups labeled with the assigned Fabric #s printed on your foundation papers. Fabric swatches are cut from each fabric color, then pasted onto each Star Group. You will need to cut **(5)** small swatches from each Fabric #L1-L8, **(12)** small swatches from Fabric #L9, and **(16)** swatches from Fabric #L10. Before you cut your foundation papers apart, use the small swatches to label them. L1 = Yellow, L2 = Orange, etc (See the Table on Page 1). You can also use the graphics on Page 3 as a guide for which locations to glue a swatch on your newsprint sheets.
