NOTE - Fabrics A9 and A10: In this pattern, we used (2) different fabrics for A9 and A10, then alternated the position of them in every other block. The Unit Chart in the Butterly Wings Booklet says you need 36" for each A9 fabric (A9:a and A9:b). However, you need 36" TOTAL of A9:a and you have an A9:a1 and an A9:a2, so you will need to split the 36" in 2 and cut (18" of each). This is explained on Page 6 of your booklet in the cutting instructions. The same applies for A10. There, you will cut (8-1/2" from each A10:a1, A10:b2, A10:a2, and A10:b1).

Group A Yardage: The yardage included in the Group A bag, is a total of the inches required for each of the fabric references that use a specific fabric. The Table to the left, for example, shows Tonga-B6875-Oatmeal is used for Fabrics A7, A8, A13, S1, S2, and S5. Use the Tables in your Butterfly Wings Booklet to subcut the yardage based on the INCHES provided in each table. Remove the labels included on the uncut yardage to label each strip as you go. Simply pull it off the total vardage, then put the label on each subcut strip. You may need to subcut the fabric yet again, as you work through your cutting instructions. For example, Eggplant will start out as 41-1/4". It will then be cut into (1) 18" Strip for Fabric A9:a1, (1) 18" strip for A9:b2, cut (1) 2-1/2" Strip for S16, and (1) 2-3/4" Strip for A4. Then, the A9:a1 and A9:b1 strips will be further subcut into (2) 9" strips each. Read through all of your cutting instructions thoroughly, particularly for Fabrics A9:a1, A9:a2, A9:b1, A9:b2, and A10:a1, A10:a2, A10:b1, and A10:b2 before cutting those fabrics to make sure you cut them correctly.
