Cutting Strips: One 3-1/2" by 42" strip cut from each Fabric J1-J9 is needed for Unit J1 with (TLS #1). Each (TLS) yields (2) template pieces, and one strip yields (4) TLS.

- One Color Group: Cut (8) 3-1/2" by 42" strips, (1) from <u>each</u> color, Fabric J1-J9.
- **Two Color Groups:** Cut **(18)** 3-1/2" by 42" strips, **(1)** from <u>each</u> color, Fabric J1:a to J9:a and J1:b to J9:b. *Note: This would increase yardage up to (18) strips.*
- More than Two Color Groups: We recommend using Alternate 1 for more than 2 Color Groups to save yardage.

Step 1: Stack the strips facing *right-side-up*. *Unit J1 (TLS #1)* is used to cut (4) pieces matching the size of the (TLS) from each color. (If you chose the two color option, cut (2) template pieces per color).



Step 2: The fabric pieces are sorted by color then stacked into (9) groups with (4) pieces. Each color group is stacked beneath one (TLS).



Step 3: Cut on Line 1 to separate the template pieces. Then, label the Sec. #s. Each color group is stacked, clipped together and placed in Bag #J1. If you have (2) Color Groups, place the :a fabrics on top and :b fabrics on the bottom of each stack.



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
