Cutting Strips: One 2" by 42" strip cut from each Fabric H2-H6 is needed to complete the cutting for each (Template Layout Sheets #2-#6). (If you are working with Two Color Groups you will need to cut (2) strips from each Fabric H2-H6.).

- One Color Group: Cut (5) 2" x 42" strips, (1) from each color • Fabric H2 to H6.
- . Two Color Groups: Cut (10) 2" by 42" strips, (1) from each color, Fabric H2:a to H6:a and H2:b to H6:b.
- More than Two Color Groups: We suggest referencing the Alternative 1 instructions if you want more than (2) Color Groups.

Step 1: Position the strip or strips facing right-side-up. One Unit H1, (TLS) is assigned to each strip.

- One Color Option: Cut (4) rectangles ۲ matching the size of each (TLS).
- Two Color Option: Stack :a fabrics on top, :b fabrics on bottom, and cut (2) rectangles per strip.

Step 2: Stack the rectangles beneath each (TLS) and cut on Line 1. Clip the templates to the fabrics beneath and place the pieces in Bag #H1.



Fabric H13: Unit H1 (TLS #13) T-Temp H-1

Cutting Strips: One 4-1/2" by 42" strip is needed to complete the cutting for both Unit H1 (T-TLS #13).



- One Color Group: Cut (1) 4-1/2" by 42" strip from Fabric H13.
- Two Color Groups: Cut (2) 4-1/2" by 42" strips, (1) from

each color, Fabric H13:a and H13:b. The (2) color option will double the yardage for (T-Temp H-1).

More than Two Color Groups: We do not recommend doing more than (2) Color Groups. It will increase yardage requirements significantly. You will also need to cut apart your T-TLS sheets before sewing the TRP lines if you do this. (4) color groups would require (4) strips, and (8) color groups would require (8) strips.

Step 3: Position the strip facing *right-side-up*. Position both of the T-Template H-1 Layout Sheet #13 onto your strip. For two colors, place one T-TLS on each strip. Cut the strips between the two T-TLS, then sew the (TRP) Lines on each T-Temp.



Step 4: After the TRP Lines are sewn the individual templates are cut out. Clip the templates and

fabric beneath into one stack. Place T-Temp H1

- One Color Group: Use Standard Color Option Instead.
- Two Color Groups: Cut (8) 2" by 42" strips, (4) from each color, Fabrics H2:a and H2:b.
- Four Color Groups: Cut (8) 2" by 42" strips, (2) from each color, Fabrics H2:a, H2:b, H2:c, Same Color Spikes and H2:d.
- **Eight Color Groups (Rainbow):** Cut (8) 2" x 42" strips, (1) from each color, Fabrics D2:a to D2:h.

Fabric H14: Unit H2 (TLS #14) T-Temp H-2

Cutting Strips: One 3" by 42" strip is needed to complete the cutting for both Unit H2 (T-TLS #14).



- One Color Group: Cut (1) 3" by 42" strip from Fabric H14.
- Two Color Groups: Cut (2) 3" by 42" strips, (1) from each color, Fabric H14:a and H14:b. The (2) color option will double the yardage for (T-Temp H-2).
- More than Two Color Groups: We do not recommend doing more than (2) Color Groups. It will increase yardage requirements significantly. You will also need to cut apart your T-TLS sheets before sewing the TRP lines if you do this. (4) color groups would require (4) strips, and (8) color groups would require (8) strips.

Step 3: Position the strip facing *right-side-up*. Position both of the T-Template H-2 Layout Sheet #14 onto your strip. For two colors, place one T-TLS on each strip. Separate the strip into two sections then sew the (TRP) Lines on each T-Temp.



Step 4: After the TRP Lines are sewn the individual templates are cut out. Clip the templates and fabric beneath into one stack. Place these pieces in Bag #H2.

- One Color Group: Use Standard Color Option Instead.
- Two Color Groups: Cut (8) 2" by 42" strips, (4) from each color, Fabrics H8:a and H8:b.
- Four Color Groups: Cut (8) 2" by 42" strips, (2) from each color, Fabrics H8:a, H8:b, H8:c, and H8:d.
- Eight Color Groups (Rainbow): Cut (8) 2" x 42" strips, (1) from each color, Fabrics H8:a to H8:h.

Step 1: Stack the strips facing *right-side-up*. Stack them in alphabetic order so that the :a fabric is on top, and the highest alphabetic number is on the bottom. One each Unit H2: (Sec 2=H2-2), (Sec 4=H2-4), (Sec 6=H2-6), (Sec 8=H2-8), & (Sec 10=H2-10) are placed onto your strips as shown. You will need to cut (TLS **#S 8-12)** apart on the cut lines before placing them on the fabric. Cut (8) pieces beneath each template.



NOTE - Correction: Please note on the Template Layout Sheets #8-12, the Sec Temp names all read the same on the first printing. It will be corrected on subsequent printings, but if you notice this on your pattern, please make the above correction to your templates before you cut them apart.

Step 2: If the fabrics were stacked in alphabetic order before cutting, then simply clip the stacks together and place them into Bag #H2. If not, then stack the pieces in each stack in alphabetic order with :a on top, then clip and store in Bag #H2.



UNITS H1 & H2: CUTTING **INSTRUCTIONS ALTERNATIVE 2**

Your foundation papers can be turned into a T-Template simply by adhering the wrong-side of the paper to the wrong-side of your fabric. This process is used to create more open space with less piecing. Normally, it requires less fabric and allows for the use of large prints and creative quilting.

Fabric Chart : Fabric H1, is assigned to Unit H1 and Fabric H7 is assigned to Unit H2.
