QUILT ASSEMBLY

Remove any remaining foundation paper from all the units at this time. Set your machine to sew a quarter-inch seam allowance. Reference the Layout Newsprint LP 57 for the Assembly Graphics 1 to 9. The graphics on LP 57 are shown assuming you would be looking at the front side of the quilt.

Assembly Graphic 1: The pieces in Groups J, K, L, B, C, and D are arranged on a design wall as shown below. Reference the grahpic at the bottom of Page 34. And, regardless of what your units were named, label each piece as shown in the graphic at the bottom of Page 34, then follow these directions. The original unit names no longer matter.

Assembly Graphic 2: Join the L Group to the B Group, and join the pieces within the D Group.

- Join L1L to B1L. Press seams toward L1L.
- Join L2L to B3L. Press seams toward B3L.
- Join L2R to B3R. Press seams toward L2R.
- Join L1R to B1R. Press seams toward B1R.
- Join DL to DR. Press seams toward DL.

Assembly Graphic 3: Join the K Group pieces on the horizontal and vertical to the L/B Group and complete the B Group.

- Join B2L to L2L/B3L. Press seams away from B2L.
- Join B2R to L2R/B3R. Press seams toward B2R.
- Join KR on the vertical and horizontal to B1L/ L1L. Press seams away from KR.
- Join KL on the vertical and horizontal to B1R/L1R. Press seams toward KL.
