**Step 2:** Place Units C1L & C2L (TLS #4) and C1R & C2R (TLS #3) on the fabric as shown, and cut each unit the size and shape of the TLS. The cutting is finished by slicing through each Cut Line to separate the individual sections.



**Step 3:** Re-sort the fabrics by color, into (3) stacks of (4) for the left units and (3) stacks of (4) for the right units. Label them as follows (note there are not enough Templates for each stack. So, when you run out, just use sticky notes and clip them to the stack. Place the Unit C1R pieces in Bag #C1R, Unit C2R pieces in Bag #C2R, the Unit C1L pieces in Bag #C1L, and the Unit C2L pieces in Bag #C2L:

- (1) stack of (4) C2:b cut with TLS #4: Unit C1L, Sec. 11

Fabric C2:c

- (1) stack of (4) C2:c cut with TLS #3: Unit C1R, Sec. 5
- (1) stack of (4) C2:c cut with TLS #3: Unit C1R, Sec. 13
- (1) stack of (4) C2:c cut with TLS #3: Unit C2R, Sec. 5
- (1) stack of (4) C2:c cut with TLS #4: Unit C1L, Sec. 5
- (1) stack of (4) C2:c cut with TLS #4: Unit C1L, Sec. 13
- (1) stack of (4) C2:c cut with TLS #4: Unit C2L, Sec. 5





- (1) stack of (4) C2:d cut with TLS #3: Unit C1R, Sec. 7
- (1) stack of (4) C2:d cut with TLS #3: Unit C1R, Sec. 15
- (1) stack of (4) C2:d cut with TLS #3: Unit C2R, Sec. 7
- (1) stack of (4) C2:d cut with TLS #4: Unit C1L, Sec. 7
- (1) stack of (4) C2:d cut with TLS #4: Unit C1L, Sec. 15
- (1) stack of (4) C2:d cut with TLS #4: Unit C2L, Sec. 7



## Fabric C3: Units C1L & C2L, C1R & C2R (TLS #5 & #6)

**Step 1:** Cut (4) 8" x 42" strips. Stack **right-side up** and sub-cut (2) stacks of 4" by 42" strips. Place Unit C1L & C2L (TLS #6) on one stack, and cut the size and shape of the TLS. The cutting is finished by slicing through each Cut Line to separate the individual sections. Clip the individual template and fabric stacks together and place (8) stacks with their associated foundation papers into Bag #C1L and (4) stacks into Bag #C2L.



**Step 2:** Place Unit C1R & C2R (TLS #5) on remaining fabric stack **right-side up**, and cut the size and shape of the TLS. The cutting is finished by slicing through each Cut Line to separate the individual sections. Clip the individual template and fabric stacks together and place **(8)** stacks with their associated foundation papers into Bag #C1R and **(4)** stacks into Bag #C2R.



▶ Fabric C4: T-Temp C3R & C4R, C3L & C4L

**Step 1:** Cut (4) 10-1/2" x 42" strips. Stack the fabrics **right-side up** and sub-cut the stack into (3) 3-1/2" strips. Place T-Template C3R on one stack and cut (4) pieces the size and shape of the template. Place T-Template C3L onto the second stack and cut (4) pieces the size and shape of that template. Place T-Templates C4L & C4R on the remaining stack of (4) fabric strips. Cut (4) pieces the size and shape of each of those templates.



**Step 2:** Set your stitch length at 2.8 and use the T-Templates as a guide to mark the TRP lines first with a marking pen, fold the paper back at each line to mark or cut a small slit and use the machine to sew into the slit. You can also hole punching them with an empty sewing needle (place the T-Template on top of the fabrics, sew along the TRP line with an empty needle to mark them all at once), then rethread your machine and sew the (TRP) Lines on each piece of fabric cut with each T-Template. The threads are trimmed on the front and backside of each template after the sewing is complete. Make sure to clip all the pieces together with the T-Template on top so you don't forget which pieces are which. Clip the pieces together and place them in Bag #C3.
