Color Layout

NOTE - Backside Graphic: The color layout shown matches the printed side of the paper, which reflects the backside of the quilt.

NOTE - Two Colorways: Note that there are two colorways of this block. Fabrics B1 to B4 will have both an :a and a :b fabric.

CUTTING: FABRICS B1-B5

NOTE - Template Reuse: Templates and (TLS) are repositioned to achieve the number of cuts required in the cutting Instructions. Please read carefully to ensure the correct # of pieces are stacked beneath each template before cutting.

NOTE - Repositionable Glue: Repositionable glue placed on the backside of each template will keep the (TLS) from moving in the cutting process and allows you to remove and reposition the template when necessary.

▶ Fabric B1:a and B1:b: Unit B2 (TLS) #1

Step 1: Cut (1) 4" by 42" strip from each *Fabric B1:a and Fabric B1:b*. Stack the strips facing *right-side up* and position *Unit B2 (TLS #1)* on top. Cut (4) pieces matching the size and shape of the TLS, (2) from each strip.



Step 2: Cut the TLS on the *Cut Line* to separate the individual pieces. Stack up all fabric pieces (with (4) Fabric B1:a on top and (4) Fabric B1:b on the bottom, then paper clip a template to the fabric beneath. Place back in Bag #B2.



Fabrics B2 through B4 (:a and :b): Units B1 & B2, (TLS) #2 & #3

Step 1: Cut (1) 4" by 42" strips *each* from *Fabrics B2:a, B2:b, B3:a, B3:b,* and *B4:a* and *B4:b* for a total of (6) strips total. Stack the strips facing *right-side up,* on your table.



Step 2: Place *Unit B1 (TLS) #2* on the left-hand end of the stack and use it to cut (12) pieces, (2) pieces from each fabric, matching the size and shape of the (TLS), repositioning the template as shown for each cut. Place *Unit B2 (TLS) #3* on the right-hand end of the stack and use it to cut (12) pieces, (2) pieces from each fabric, matching the size and shape of the (TLS).



Step 3: Separate the pieces cut with Fabric TLS #2 into (3) stacks of (4) fabrics each, by Fabric Reference (so, one stack will be for the B2:a and B2:b fabrics, one will be for B3:a and B3:b, and one will be for B4:a and B4:b). Repeat that same stacking process for the pieces cut with TLS #3.

Step 4: Starting with Fabrics B2:a and B2:b, Place a *(TLS) #2* or *(TLS) #3* paper on each, respective stack. Complete the cutting by slicing through the paper on each *Cut Line* to separate the individual sections.

Step 5: Stack with the **(4)** B2:a fabrics on top and the **(4)** B2:b fabrics on the bottom. Clip the section templates to the fabric beneath. Place Unit B1 templates in Bag #B1. Place Unit B2 templates in Bag #B2.



Step 6: Repeat with Fabrics B3 and B4.

Fabric B5: Units B1 & B2 (TLS) #4, #5, #6 & #7

NOTE - Using Quiltster: If you precut your fabric strips using the Quiltster APP, you will need to sub-cut each 26" strip into **(4)** 3-1/2" strips and **(3)** 4" strips to achieve the number of strips listed in Step 1.

Step 1: Cut (8) 3-1/2" x 42" strips and (6) 4" x 42" strips from *Fabric B5.*

Step 2: Stack the **(8)** 3-1/2" x 42" strips with fabric facing *right-side up*. Position *Unit B1 (TLS) #4* on the left-hand end of the stack and *Unit B2 (TLS) #5* on the right-hand end. Cut **(8)** pieces matching the size and shape of each (TLS).



Step 3: Complete the cutting by slicing through the paper on each *Cut Line* to separate the individual sections. Use paper clips to keep the fabric and template pieces together in each section. Place Unit B1 templates in Bag #B1. Place Unit B2 templates in Bag #B2.



Step 4: Stack (2) of the 4" x 42" strips with fabric facing *right-side up*. Position *Unit B1 (TLS) #6* on the stack and cut (8) pieces matching the size and shape of the (TLS), repositioning the template as shown for each cut.



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
