**Step 10:** Flip the papers over, press the fabric pieces open on each paper.

**Step 11:** Position the fold template over the top of Sections 1 and 2, lining the edge up with Line 2 and fold back the paper.

**Step 12:** Trim the fabric with the *Add-A-Quarter* ruler.

Step 13: Position the third fabric piece next to Sec. 3.

**Step 14:** Slide the fabric under Sec. 3. Line the sew-side up with the raw edge of the trimmed quarter-inch seams allowance.



**NOTE - Chain Piecing:** Repeat steps 11-13 on each paper before moving onto Step 14.

Step 15: Open the paper, sew on Line 2 and press.

**Step 16:** Complete the foundation paper piecing, on each of the B1 Units.

**Step 17:** When the paper piecing is complete, flip the unit over and look for the Registration lines (small dotted lines along the edge of the unit labeled TRP). **Step 15** 

**Step 18:** Trim away the excess fabric and paper using *Registration Lines* the exterior solid line on each foundation unit.

**Step 19:** Using a basting stitch (stitch length 2.8), sew the length of the dotted line to mark this location,

which will help later in final assembly.

**Step 20:** Trim around the foundation paper on the outside solid line, which trims the threads from sewing the registration lines. Do not remove the paper at this time. Place everything back into Bag B1 until you are ready to assemble the project.
