• Three Color Groups: Cut (1) 4-3/4" by 42" strip from <u>each</u> color Fabric B2:a through B2:c.

• **Twelve Color Groups:** Reference the Rainbow cutting option in the introduction booklet.

Step 1: Place the fabric strip(s) facing right-side-up. Position the **(6)** (TLS) labeled *Units B1 & B2 Template Layout Sheet #1* onto the fabric strip(s) starting at the left edge. The backside of each layout sheet is placed against the right-side of the fabric and secured with

repositionable glue. If you chose more than one color group, refer to the previous diagrams for each color group for how many (TLS) to place on each strip.

NOTE - Repositionable Glue can be your friend when used correctly: Remember, a small amount of repositionable glue applied to the backside of your templates and (TLS) prior to adhering them onto your fabrics allows you to reposition the templates if needed.

Step 2: Cut around each layout sheet leaving about 1/8" of excess fabric along each edge. Set your stitch length at 2.0 and sew the (TRP) Lines on each layout sheet. After the (TRP) lines are sewn, trim the threads on the front and backside of each layout sheet. (The TRP lines are needed when curved piecing, so don't skip this step!)



NOTE - Chain-Piece the TRPs: To speed up the sewing process, lift the needle at the end of each dotted line, and move the paper under the presser foot to the next (TRP) line, without cutting the threads. Begin sewing on the next line.



Step 3: Trim the excess fabric off around the perimeter of each layout sheet, then cut the individual template sections apart on Cut Lines 1–5. Discard the scrap in the middle of each pair of templates. (*Note: Leave the template paper attached to each fabric piece until told to remove when assembling the units.*)



Step 4: If you have chosen to use more than one color group, stack each of the four template numbers in reverse alphabetical order starting with the latest alphabetical fabric on the bottom and ending with *Fabric B2:a* on top. Clip the template/fabric pieces together and place into Bags #B1 & B2 with their assigned foundation units.

▶ Fabric B3: Units B1 & B2 (TLS #2 & #3)

Cutting Strips: Two 9" by 42" strips are needed to complete the cutting for **Units B1 & B2 (TLS) #2** and **#3** from Fabric B3. (If you have selected more than (2) fabrics for Fabric B3, you will need one strip additional strip from each fabric.)

• One Color Group: Cut (2) 9" by 42" strips from Fabric B3.
