Color Layout

NOTE - Backside Graphic: The color layout shown matches the printed side of the paper, and the backside of the quilt.

NOTE - Stacking strips: Templates and (TLS) are repositioned on the cut strips to achieve the number of cuts required in the cutting Instructions. Please read carefully to ensure the correct # of pieces are stacked beneath each Template before cutting.

NOTE - Glue: Repositionable glue placed on the backside of each template will keep the templates and (TLS) from moving in the cutting process. After each cut simply reposition the template to the next location.

Fabric C1: Unit A and Temp AL & AR

Step 1: Cut (6) 4-1/2" by 42" strips and (5) 4" strips from Fabric A1 and position into the following stacks, facing right-side up on your cutting table.

Cut (3) 4-1/2" x 42" strips for Temp A-3 & A-7 TLS

Cut (3) 4-1/2" x 42" strips for Temp A-2 & A-8 TLS

Cut (3) 4" x 42" strips for Temp AL

Cut (2) 4" x 42" strips for Temp AR (You will cut (2) extra pieces from the 3rd AL strip excess and (2) from the TLS A-2 to A-7 excess)

Step 2: Place the Unit A Background TLS A-3 & A-7 on one set of (3) 4-1/2" x 42" strips. Cut (8) pieces of fabric, the size and shape of the TLS. Repeat this process with the other set of (3) 4-1/2" x 42" strips and the Temp A-2 & A-8 TLS.



Step 3: Restack the fabrics right-side up, then place the

respective TLS on top of each stack. Cut through the paper and fabric on Lines 1 to 8, in numerical order, to separate the template pieces for each section.

Bag A with the Unit A papers.



Step 4: Clip the templates and the fabric pieces together for each section. Place the stacks back into

Step 5: Place Templates AL and AR on the (2) stacks of (2) 4" x 42" strips, as shown. Cut (12) pieces using each template.



Step 6: From the last 4" strip, cut (4) Temp AL and (2) Temp A4 for a total of (16), ea. Then, from the leftover pieces in Step 2 from your Temp A-2 to A-8 pieces, cut the final (2) pieces of Temp AR. Clip all (16) of each together and place into Bag A.



Fabric C2: Unit A, A-1 TLS

Step 1: Cut (2) 5" x 42" strips and stack them right-side up. Position the A-1 TLS onto both strips and subcut (8) pieces the size and shape of the TLS.



Step 2: Re-stack the fabric pieces under the layout sheet facing right-side up. Cut through the paper and fabric, in numerical order, on the Cut Lines, for a total of (32) pieces the size of *Temp* A-1. Clip all the pieces together under (1) Template and place with the foundation papers in Bag A.

Fabric C3: Unit A, A-4 & A-5 TLS

Step 1: Cut (2) 5" x 42" strips and place next to each other, right-side up.
