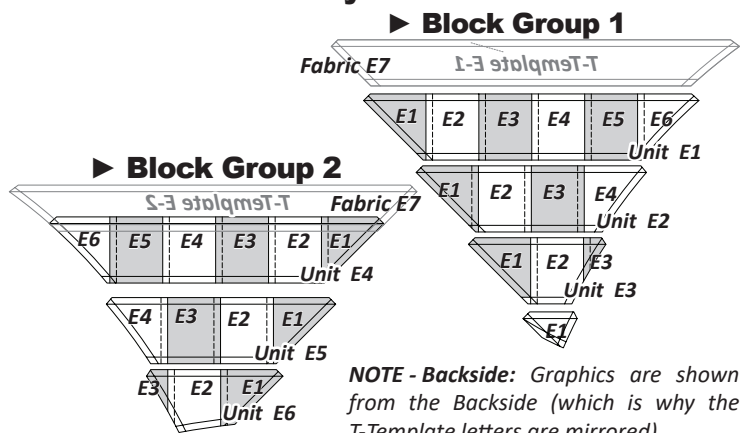


► Standard Color Layout



Fabric Chart: The yardage listed for Fabrics E1–E6 in the fabric chart is calculated for creating (4) blocks based off a One Color Group Option. If you plan to use multicolor groups, refer to the Color Groups specified under each Fabric # in the cutting instructions. These references will help you calculate the required yardage for each color accordingly.

Units E1-E6, T-Temps E-1 to E-3 (Wall Size) Standard Yardage: Make (4) Each		
GROUP E FABRIC #	YARDAGE INCH	ASSIGNED COLOR
<u>Fabric E1</u> Units E1-E6: (Temp S-1, T-TLS #1)	$\frac{1}{4}$ yd or (6")	FABRIC SWATCH
<u>Fabric E2</u> Units E1-E6: (Temp S-1)	$\frac{1}{4}$ yd or (6")	FABRIC SWATCH
<u>Fabric E3</u> Units E1-E6: (Temp S-1)	$\frac{1}{4}$ yd or (6")	FABRIC SWATCH
<u>Fabric E4</u> Units E1, E2, E4, E5: (Temp S-1)	$\frac{1}{4}$ yd or (6")	FABRIC SWATCH
<u>Fabric E5</u> Units E1, E2, E4, E5: (Temp S-1)	$\frac{1}{8}$ yd or (3")	FABRIC SWATCH
<u>Fabric E6</u> Units E1, E4: (Temp S-1)	$\frac{1}{8}$ yd or (3")	FABRIC SWATCH
<u>Fabric E7</u> T-Templates E-1 & E-2	$\frac{1}{4}$ yd or (8")	FABRIC SWATCH

► Tip for Multi Color Quilts

Labeling Fabrics: For multiple color groups, label each fabric with a small letter after its reference (e.g., A1:a, A1:b, A1:c).

► Fabrics E1- E6: Unit E1- E6 (Temp S1)

Preparing Your Strips:

- **Fabric E1:** Cut two (2) strips measuring 3" X 42".

- **Fabric E2:** Cut two (2) strips measuring 3" X 42".

- **Fabric E3:** Cut two (2) strips measuring 3" X 42".

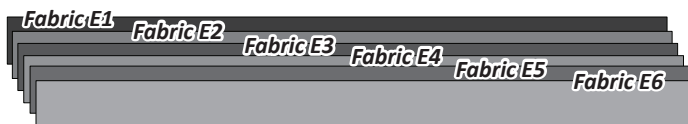
- **Fabric E-4:** Cut two (2) strips measuring 3" X 42".

- **Fabric E-5:** Cut one (1) strips measuring 3" X 42".

- **Fabric E-6:** Cut one (1) strips measuring 3" X 42".

Stacking Strips: The fabrics strips are organized into two groups for cutting.

- **Group One:** Stack one (1) strip each, Fabrics E1-E6. Arrange with Fabric E1 at the bottom ending with Fabric E6 on the top.

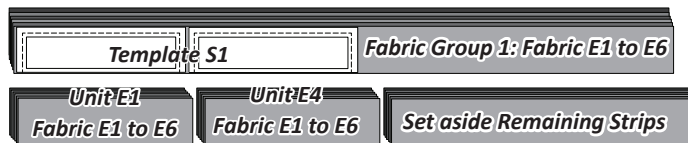


- **Group Two:** Stack one (1) strip each, Fabrics E1-E4. Arrange with Fabric E1 at the bottom ending with Fabric E4 on the top.



Group One Cutting, Template S-1:

- **Cutting Strip Group One:** Using *Template S-1*, cut two (2) strip groups measuring 3" by 11" from the stacked fabric (E1-E6). Assign one group to **Unit E1** and the other to **Unit E4**.



- **Prepare Unit E1 Pieces:** Re-stack the fabrics for Unit E1 with Fabric E6 at the bottom, ending with Fabric E1 on top. Pair with **Foundation Sheet E1**, in **Bag E1**.



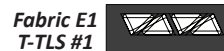
- **Prepare Unit E4 Pieces:** Don't restack these strips and pair with **Foundation Sheet E4**, in **Bag E2**.



- **Adjusting Remaining Strips for Unit E3:** Remove Fabrics E4, E5, & E6 from the remaining strips. Using *Template S-1*, cut one additional strip group measuring 3" by 11" from Fabrics E1, E2, & E3. Re-stack the fabric pieces in reverse order starting with Fabric E3 at the bottom, Fabric E1 on Top. Pair these pieces with **Foundation Sheet E3**, for **Unit E3**, and place in **Bag E1**.



- **T-Template E-3 Instructions:** Remove the left over Fabric E1 from the scrap pile. *T-Template E-3 Layout Sheet* is used to cut (4) pieces from Fabric E1. Clip the templates to the fabric beneath and place in **Bag E1**.



Group Two Cutting, Template S-1:

- **Cutting Strip Group Two:** Using *Template S-1*, cut two (2) strip groups measuring 3" by 11" from the stacked strips, Fabric (E1-E4). One group is assigned to **Unit E2** and the other to **Unit E5**.
