COLOR OPTIONS: BLOCKS IN GROUP B

There are three color options available in Quiltster for the Unit Blocks in Group B.

Standard Option:

- **Standard Option:** Fabrics B1 through B7 and Lone Star, Fabrics S1-S16.
- **Color Option 1:** Fabrics B1, B2, B3, and B7 along with Lone Star, Fabrics S1- S16. Recommended for quilts with multiple colors (e.g., two-color, four-color, or eight-color schemes). This option was used for all the rainbow quilts show on the coversheets.
- **Color Option 2:** Fabrics B1, B2, and B7 along with Lone Star Fabrics S1- S16.

Cutting Instructions:

Cutting instructions for Fabrics S1-S16 used in Foundation Sheets B1-B4 start on **Page 8.** The Diamond Star Units are compatible with all three options.

- **Supported Options:** Cutting instructions are provided for two color groups.
- Unsupported Options: If using more than two color groups for the diamonds, you will need to calculate your own yardage. If you used Quiltster to design your quilt, Quiltster will calculate a lot of extra yardage and the piecing and assembly instructions will not accommodate these changes.

NOTE - : The strip piecing process for Foundation Sheets B1-B4 is designed in sets of four. If you are using Quiltster and unlock the blocks, then assign different colors to each star group, you will need to cut the foundation sheets apart and shorten the cutting templates for each diamond. This method is not supported in the instructions or Quiltster yardage calculations.

- Standard Option: (Fabrics B1-B7) instructions are listed first.
- **Color Option 1:** (Fabrics B1, B2, B3 and B7) instructions are listed second. This option is ideal for quilts using multiple color schemes, such as two-color, four-color, or eight-color groups. (e.g., the Rainbow cutting layouts. (*Note: For the four-color option, yardage for Fabrics B1 and B7 will double*).
- **Color Option 2:** (Fabrics B1, B2, and B7)instructions are listed third. This option is also suitable for multiple color schemes like the Option 1.

Yardage Information:

All the Yardage Charts are based on the "One Color Group", where all eight blocks use the same combination of colors.

If your quilt uses multiple color groups, the total inches shown will be split between the different fabrics if the yardage does not change. In some cases, using multiple colors may increase the total yardage required:

Two-Color Group:

- Four blocks use one color group, and the other four blocks use a second color group.
- Yardage for fabrics B1 and B7 doubles.
- Total yardage increases by approximately 3/4 yard.



Four Color Group:

- Two blocks are assigned to one of four color groups.
- Yardage for fabrics B1 and B7 doubles
- Total yardage increases by approximately 3/4 yard.

Eight-Color Group:

- One block uses each of the eight colors.
- Refer to the Rainbow cutting option provided in the Wall or Queen Introduction Booklet for more efficient fabric usage.
