• One Color Group: Cut (4) strips measuring 3-1/2" by 42" from fabric Fabric B7.

Templates: The templates you are looking for are printed on Units B5 & B6 (TLS) #5-#12, assigned to the spikes sections on your foundation units.

- Cut each (TLS) apart along Cut Line 1.
- One section template on each layout sheet will be used to cut the spike sections for Units B5 and B6 from all colors.
- The remaining section templates are not used and can be discarded.

Stacking and Cutting: Place the strips right-side up on your cutting surface. If using multiple colors, stack strips in reverse alphabetical order ending with Fabric B3:a on top.

Unit B6 Templates: Arrange the templates along the left side of the stacked strips and secure with repositionable glue. Cut eight **(8)** pieces for each template, then clip the templates to the fabric, and place in Bag #3.



Unit B5 Templates: Using the remaining strips, repeat the process for Unit B5 templates. Clip the pieces to the templates and place in Bag #B5.
