


Step 4: Cut around each layout sheet leaving about 1/8" of excess fabric around the edges of each unit.

Step 5: Set your stitch length to *Sew Basting Line 2*, and the (TRP) Lines on each layout sheet. After sewing the (TRP) lines, trim any loose threads from both the fabric and paper-side of each unit.



Step 6: Once the TRP Lines are sewn, set the foundation units aside. Repeat the process for the remaining strips to prepare the additional foundation units. Each strip provides enough fabric to yield two units, so cutting two strips will give you the four units needed for H1 and H4. Keep these templates in Bag H1 until you are ready to sew the veins.

Unit H2 and Unit H3: Refer to the instructions under **Option 1**, on Page 6, Column 1 for a full set of instructions for Units H2 and H3.



GROUP H: OPTION 3 CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

► Option 3, Fabric Chart:

The yardage listed in the chart is calculated to make (4) blocks using the One Color Group. H1 to H4 are the same as the Standard option. Fabric H5 will be different. This Option also requires H6 to H18. Please use the table on Page 4 for these fabrics.



► Fabric H5: Units H1- H4 (Temp H1-1), (Temp H4-1), and Units H2 & H3


NOTE - Quiltster APP: Sub-cut each 17-1/2" strip into (8) 5" strips and (4) 7-1/2" strips.

Cutting Fabric Strips: Cut (8) strips measuring 5" by 42" from Fabric H5. Stack strips *right-side-up* in two stacks with (4) strips.


Unit H4, Temp H4-1: Position (Temp H4-1) onto the stack, cut (4) pieces. Clip the templates to the fabric and place in Bag #H1.



Unit H1, Temp H1-1: Position (Temp H1-1) onto the stack, cut (4) pieces. Clip the templates to the fabric and place in Bag #H1.



Unit H2 and Unit H3: Refer to the instructions under Option 1, on Page 6, Column 1 for a full set of instructions for Units H2 and H3.



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:

- Alternative Option 1: Follow the paper piecing instructions on Page 10 & 11. Alternative Templates H1-1 and H4-1 replace Section 1 & 2 on Units H1 & H4. The remaining sections use the same piecing instructions.
- Template H1 and H2: The curved piecing graphics for all the veins are shared for all four options provided for Group H. Curved piecing instructions, Page 11.
