NOTE - *: Your A and B Spike Templates may references Fabrics A2:a, A2:b, and A2:c or B2:a, B2:b, And B2:c. In this pattern, we only used (2) fabrics for each spike. Don't worry about the :c reference, just cut the # of pieces noted in the cutting instructions. The same goes for Fabric #C3. In the past, we only used (3) Fabrics. Now, we are using (4) repeated fabrics, or up to (8) different fabrics so ignore the Fabric Reference on the Template.
