## Chapter 5:

Bag #10, Templates B1R, B3R, B4R, B6R,  
Templates B1L, B3L, B4L, B6L,

### Round 5: Cutting Instructions: Cream Color B5, and Navy Blue Color B6,

**Cutting the Strips:** Two colors are used to complete the cutting for the background templates. Cream Color B5, (APTM-14264-15), from which templates, B1 left & right, and B4R, left & right are cut, Navy Blue Color B6, (APTM-14264-213) from which templates B3 left & right, and B6R, left & right are cut.

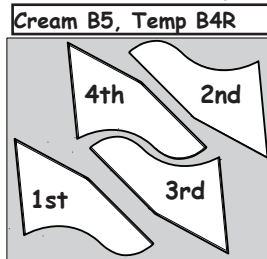
**Cream Color B5, Background:** Cut (2) 35" by 42" strips across the width of the fabric. Place with the B4 Templates. Cut (1) 30" by 42" piece and place with the B1 Templates.

**Navy Color B6, Background:** Cut (4) 11" by 42" strips across the width of the fabric. Place with the B6 Templates. Then cut (4) 18" by 42" strips across the width of the fabric and place with the B3 Templates.

#### Border Background Fabric, Color B5 Subcutting Instructions

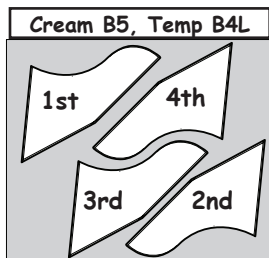
#### Cream Color B5, Background Templates, Bag #10 Templates B4R & B4L and B1R & B1L

1: Open the 35" by 42" strips cut from Color B5 Cream, *right-sides-up* and place on your cutting board. Position Template B4R onto the fabric in the first position as shown and cut out the first template piece. Repeat for each of the four pieces. Flower pins should be used to pin the paper templates to the fabric before cutting.

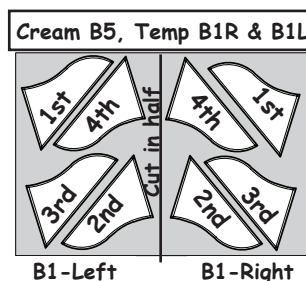


**Note:** You will need to reposition the template to make the necessary cuts.

2: Clip the template and fabric pieces together and place back into Bag #10. **Note:** Keep the templates and fabric pieces together as they are marked with registration points to help you with your curved piecing when you assemble your quilt.



**Template B4L:** Repeat Steps 1 and 2, and cut (4) pieces for Template B4L from the other 35" by 42" strip.

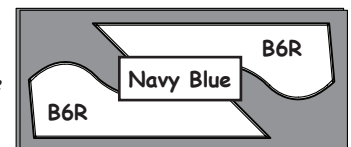


**Template B1R and B1L:** Cut the 30" x 42" rectangle in half then position the templates as shown and cut one template off at a time. Cut (4) pieces for each template.

#### Border Background Fabric, Color B5 Subcutting Instructions

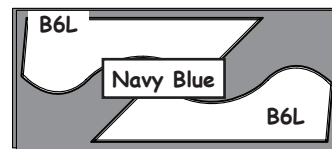
#### Navy Blue Color B6, Background Templates, Bag #10 Templates B6R & B6L and B3R & B3L

1: Open (2) 18" by 42" strips cut from Color B6-Navy, and stack *right-sides-up*. Using Template B6R, carefully cut out (4) pieces for each template.



**Note:** Reposition all templates to make the necessary cuts.

2: Clip the template and fabric pieces together and place back into Bag #10.



**Template B6L:** Open and stack the other (2) 18" by 42" strips and cut (4) pieces using Template B6L. Place the pieces in Bag #10.

**Template B3R:** Open and stack (2) 11" by 42" strip and cut (4) pieces using Template B3R. Place the pieces in Bag #10.



**Template B3L:** Open and stack (2) 11" by 42" strip and cut (4) pieces using Template B3R. Place the pieces in Bag #10.



#### General Instructions for Assembling your Quilt

To assemble your quilt, there are some special piecing techniques you will need to use, including completing S-Curves and Y-seams. This section provides a general description of these two techniques for you to reference while sewing together your quilt top. On Page 3, we have included a table that outlines the order in which you will sew your units together, as well as the direction you will press each seam as you assemble your quilt top. Additionally, we have provided you with the sub-sections that you will sew together for reference.
